Sneak preview of Microsoft Outlook 2003 & IBM Lotus Notes 6.5 Support

As some of you may have already know by now, REDiSAFE is due to release a version for Microsoft Outlook and IBM Lotus Notes backup and recovery. This means you will now be able to incrementally backup your emails on REDiSAFE in a simple and seamless manner.

How does it work?

REDiSAFE supports backup and recovery for Microsoft Outlook 2003 & IBM Lotus Notes.

Backing Up



The user must have the REDiSAFE client installed with an account registered within the REDiSAFE server.

Once installed, the plug-in will auto-run in the background whenever the clients are started.



After the initial installation, users simply need to log in and select the folder to backup and schedule the frequency of the backup. The plug-in will then perform an initial backup of all the items in the selected folders. Depending on the size of the folders selected, the initial backup may take a few minutes.

The plug-in will then monitor all items coming into the selected folder and backup each item instantaneously to a folder on the local hard disk.

The REDiSAFE Agent will then backup the emails from the local hard disk to the REDiSAFE Server based on the frequency set by the user.

After backing up to the server, the items in the local folder will be auto-deleted to conserve storage space on the user PC.

Restoration

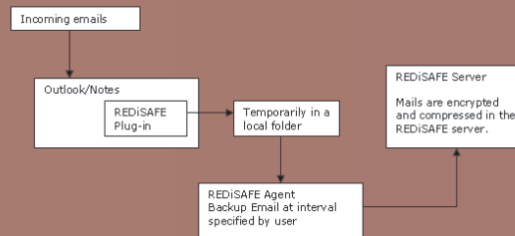


Clicking on the restoration option on the menu will bring up a window displaying the date of backup. Each date will comprise of all the folders backed up.

The user can then select the dates from which the emails are to be restored.

Files backed up on those dates selected will then be restored to a new PST or NSF files.

Configuration



Only the schedule for the plug-in backup can be changed from the configuration menu.

The rest of the configuration will be changed from the REDiSAFE Client.
